HOW IS MY DOLLAR SPENT?

When a dollar is contributed through the Alabama Hunger Offering, 50% is used within the state of Alabama to assist Baptist churches and associations with food pantries. The remainder will be divided 80/20 (80% to the International Mission Board for overseas hunger relief projects and 20% to the North American Mission Board to support hunger relief projects in the United States and Canada). Because personnel and volunteers are already in place and promotional expenses come through other budgets, 100% of your gift is used to minister to the hungry in Jesus' name.
